

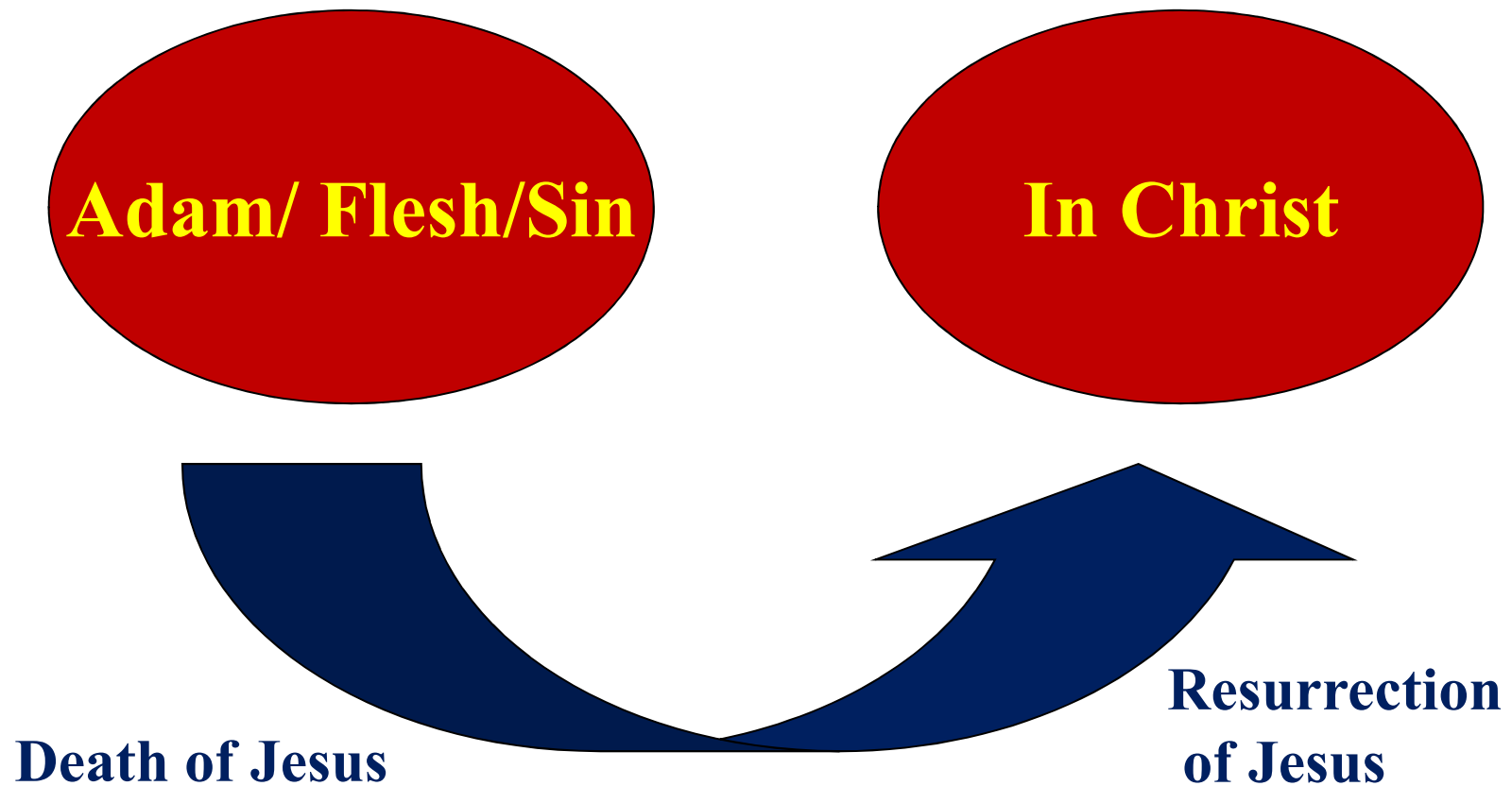
# The Renewal We Receive

# Uper in 2 Cor 5:14b-20

- one has died **on behalf** of all (14b)
- he died **on behalf of all** so that those living no longer live for themselves but for the one dying and being raised **on behalf of them.**(15)
- we are ambassadors **on behalf of Christ** (20)
- we beg you **on behalf of Christ** (20)
- the one not knowing sin was made sin **on our behalf** (21)

# Old Order and Recreation in Paul



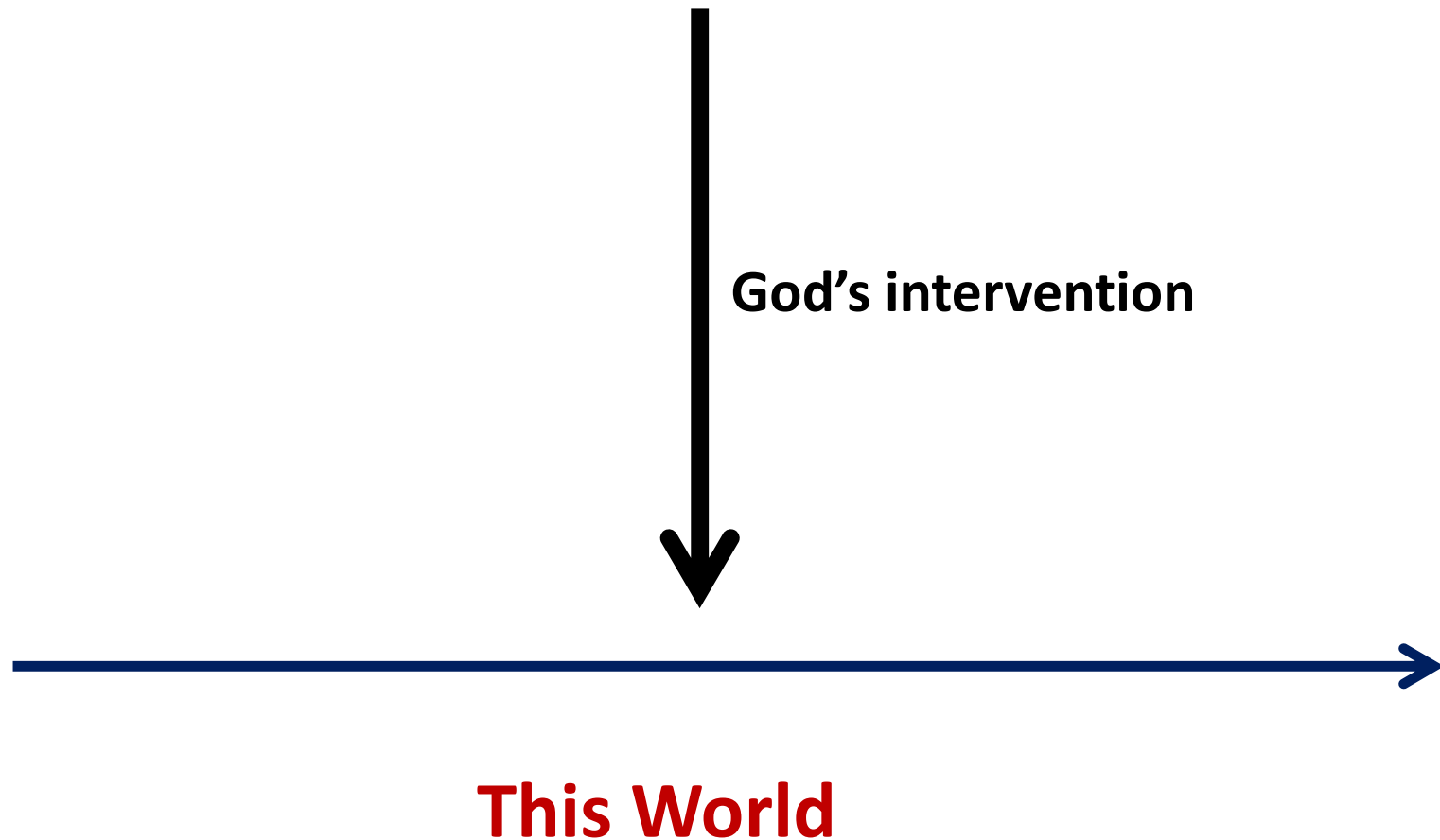
# οἶδα and γινωσκω

- γινωσκω (ginosko) = intellectual knowledge

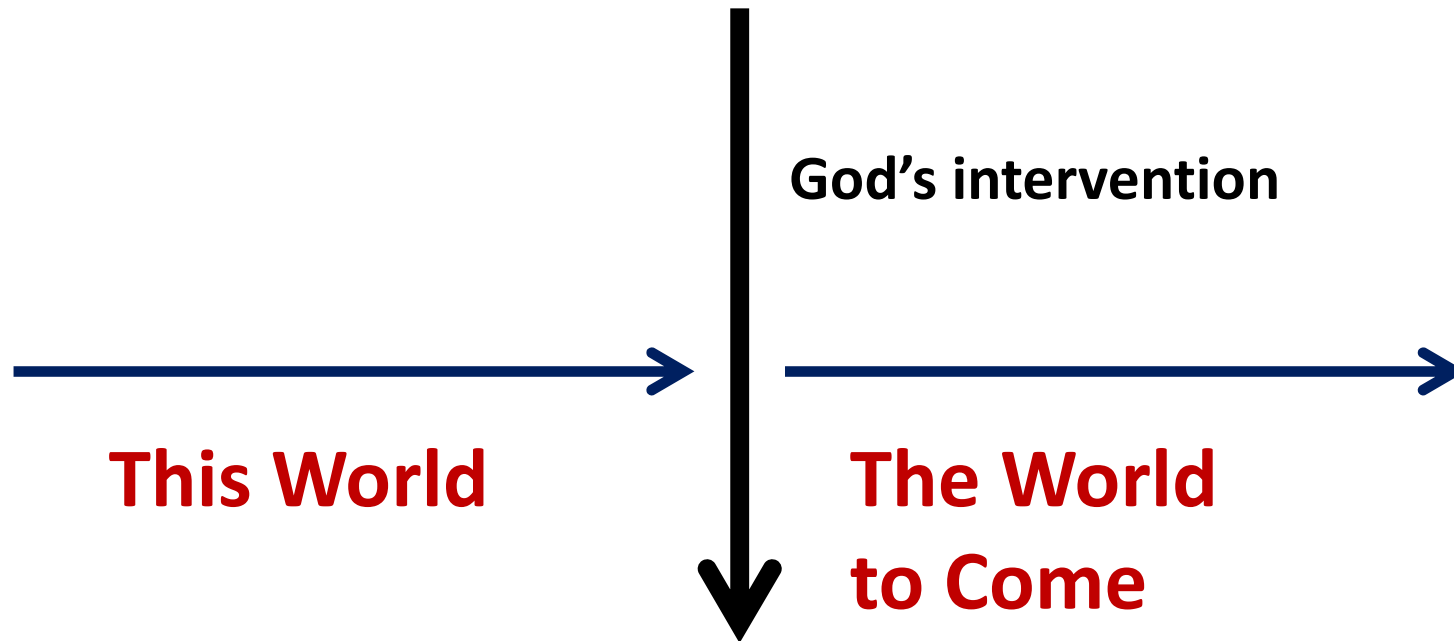
# Translation options for if anyone is in Christ new creation

- NIV 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation;
- NRS 2 Corinthians 5:17 So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation
- ASV 2 Corinthians 5:17 Wherefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature:
- NLT 2 Corinthians 5:17 What this means is that those who become Christians become new persons.

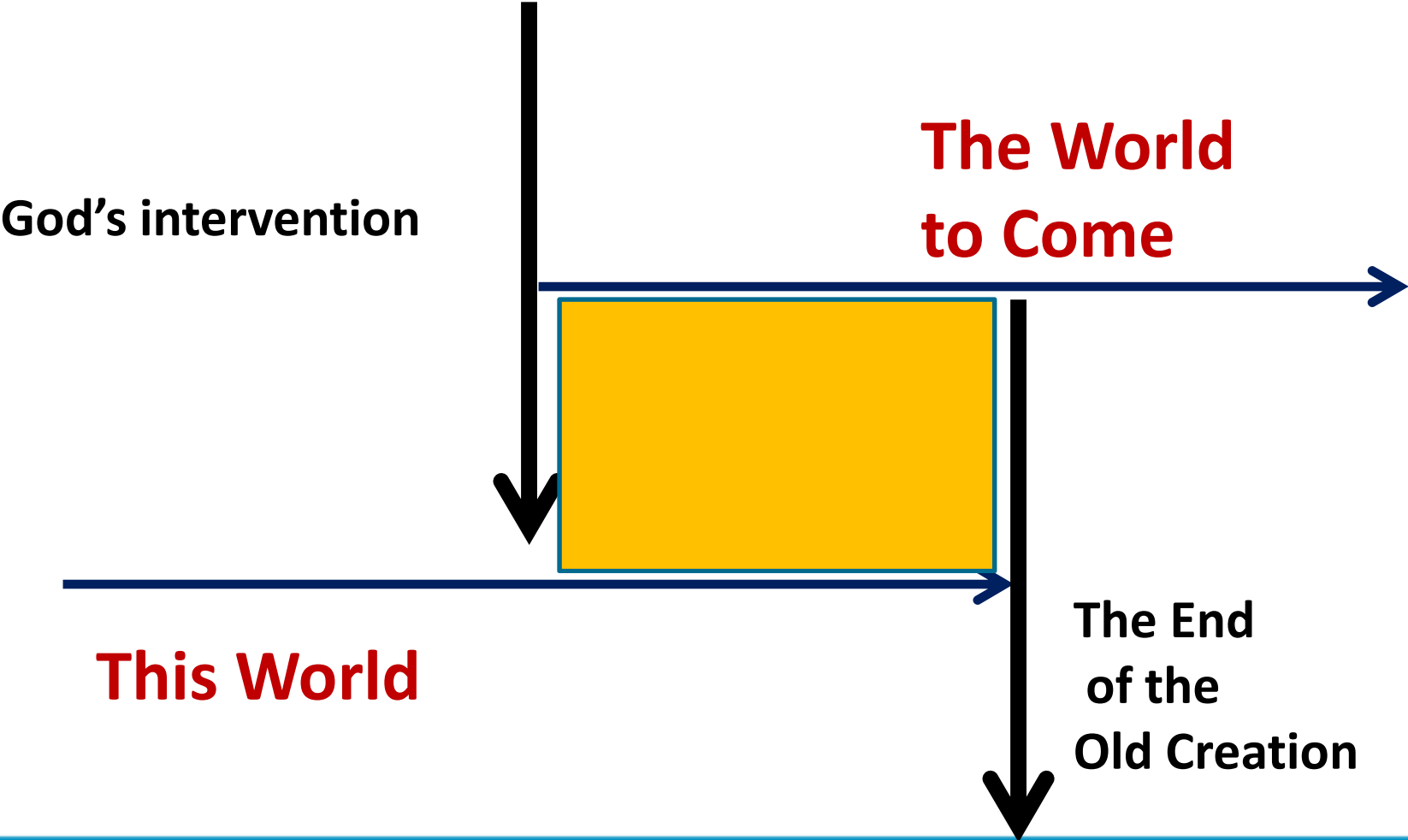

- When St. Paul says that God has given him the ministry of reconciliation, he means that he is a preacher of this peace. He ministers reconciliation to the world. . . .
